## Important Notice Regarding Your Child Support Prepaid Debit Card

Dear Child Support Customer,

The Nevada Child Support Enforcement Program is changing debit card vendors.

If you are a child support recipient receiving payments via a prepaid USBank ReliaCard debit card, you will soon receive a new Way2Go Card® prepaid Mastercard.

The Way2Go Card allows you to track Nevada Child Support payments and purchases on your card through:

- The Way2Go web portal at *https://www.goprogram.com*
- Way2Go app (available for iOS and Android devices)

## What to expect:

- You will continue to receive your Nevada Child Support payments on your current USBank ReliaCard through February 29, 2024.
- Starting on March 1, 2024, all payments will automatically be deposited to your new Way2Go card.

## Actions to take when you receive your new Way2Go Card:

- 1. Activate your new Way2Go Card as soon as you receive it to prevent any delays getting your child support payments.
- 2. As soon as you activate your new Way2Go Card, go to *https://www.goprogram.com/goedcrecipient/#/* and/or download the mobile Way2Go application to set-up account alerts. Setting up account alerts lets you know when you have received a deposit and helps you manage your transactions.

If you do not want to receive child support payments on a debit card, you may receive your payments through direct deposit into a personal checking or savings account. To do this, visit <u>https://dwss.nv.gov/Support/1\_1\_3Child\_Support\_-\_Receiving\_Payments/</u> and complete a direct deposit form.
